Published annually since its inception, the Chinese version records China's reform and development achievements, national policies, and major events. It serves three core functions: preserving history, providing governance information, and educating the public, and has become an authoritative publication for the international community to understand China. The 2024 edition features 36 sections, including the Constitution, geography, state institutions, national defense, and foreign affairs of China, with approximately 2.8 million Chinese characters and over 100 historically significant images.
